This course will teach us to understand how the Psalms reflect the realities of everyday life and how to use these songs of praise and faith to grow deeper in our spiritual life.

Malaysian Church History

Early bird registration by: January 2, 2023

This course seeks to explore the origin and development of the Christian churches in Malaysia by examining selected denominational histories of the various denominations (e.g., the Anglicans and Methodists, among others, not forgetting the Pentecostal -Charismatic movement). The responses of the local churches towards autonomy from their mission societies, their witness and outreach will also be examined against the broader canvas of the historical processes within and without the country that impinge on the life and work of the Malaysian Church. Selected examples of how the mission bodies and their local churches responded to the socio-economic and political realities of the country will also be discussed. In addition, there will be a thematic study on Christian mission and the state in Sarawak and a biographical study of a Christian personality.

It is also fascinating to learn about God's dealings with the people of Israel and their neighboring nations in order to accomplish his redemptive purpose.

Foundations of Pastoral Counseling

This course is designed to help participants explore the themes of listening to self, listening to others and listening to God. In order to fully understand the art of listening, students need to learn to discern the inner voices we all carry as part of our own childhood wounds, learned behaviors, and inherited traditions. These can become blocks to listening and create defensive stances and postures between the counselor and the client. Students will also explore being able to hold a sacred space for their clients who come to explore their own problems and difficulties. Practical activities will include triad work, small group discussion, and prayer.

There are two parts to this course. The first part is designed to provide students with the foundation of contextual dimensions, basic knowledge, and skills for functioning as competent lay counselors within their communities. Basic theoretical, scriptural and practical issues will be considered, including the need for a balanced approach to counselor self-care.
