





Exploring Early Christian Faith Through Creeds

正典圣经出现之前,有信经,是早期基督徒的权威性基本信仰纲要。 信经不是圣经,但却是信仰的一种伟大的简明的教义提纲。 圣经和信经的真理是一样,只是表达方式不同,语言不同。信经是用逻辑语言,系统条文, 用字严谨,而圣经是用日常生活语言,容易明白。


