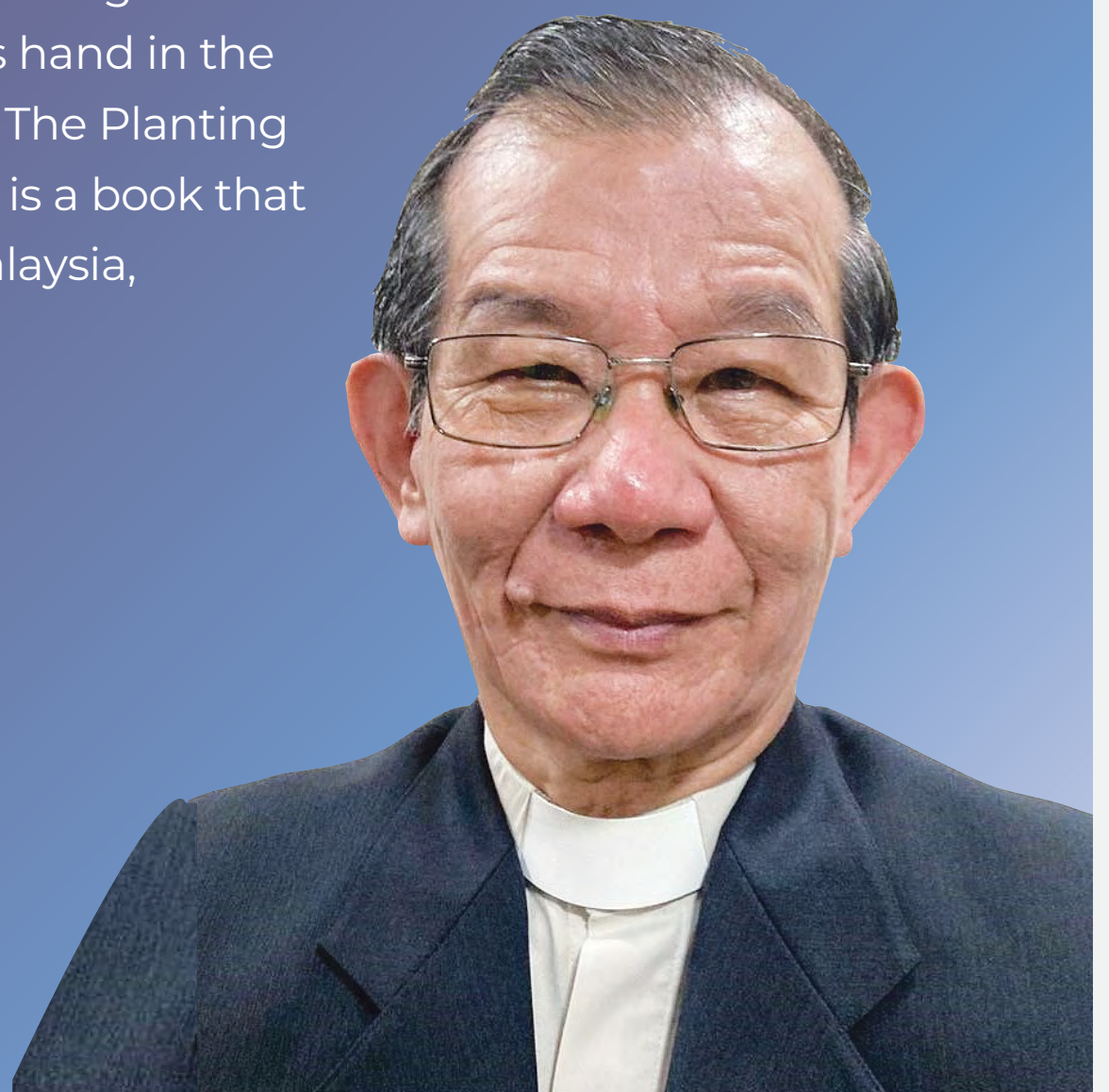

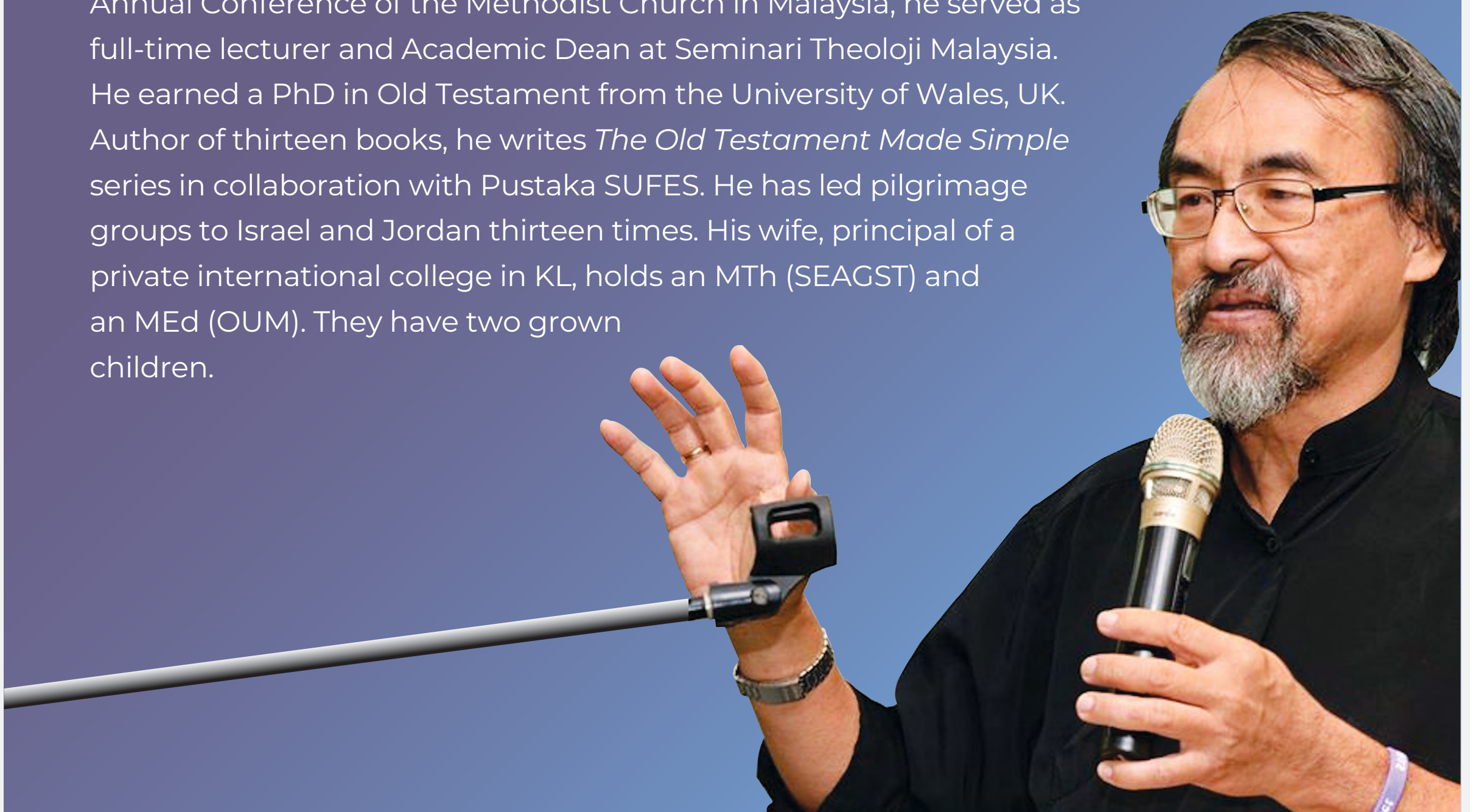

The primary goal is to equip students with foundational skills for biblical exegesis rather than fluency in listening, reading, or speaking.

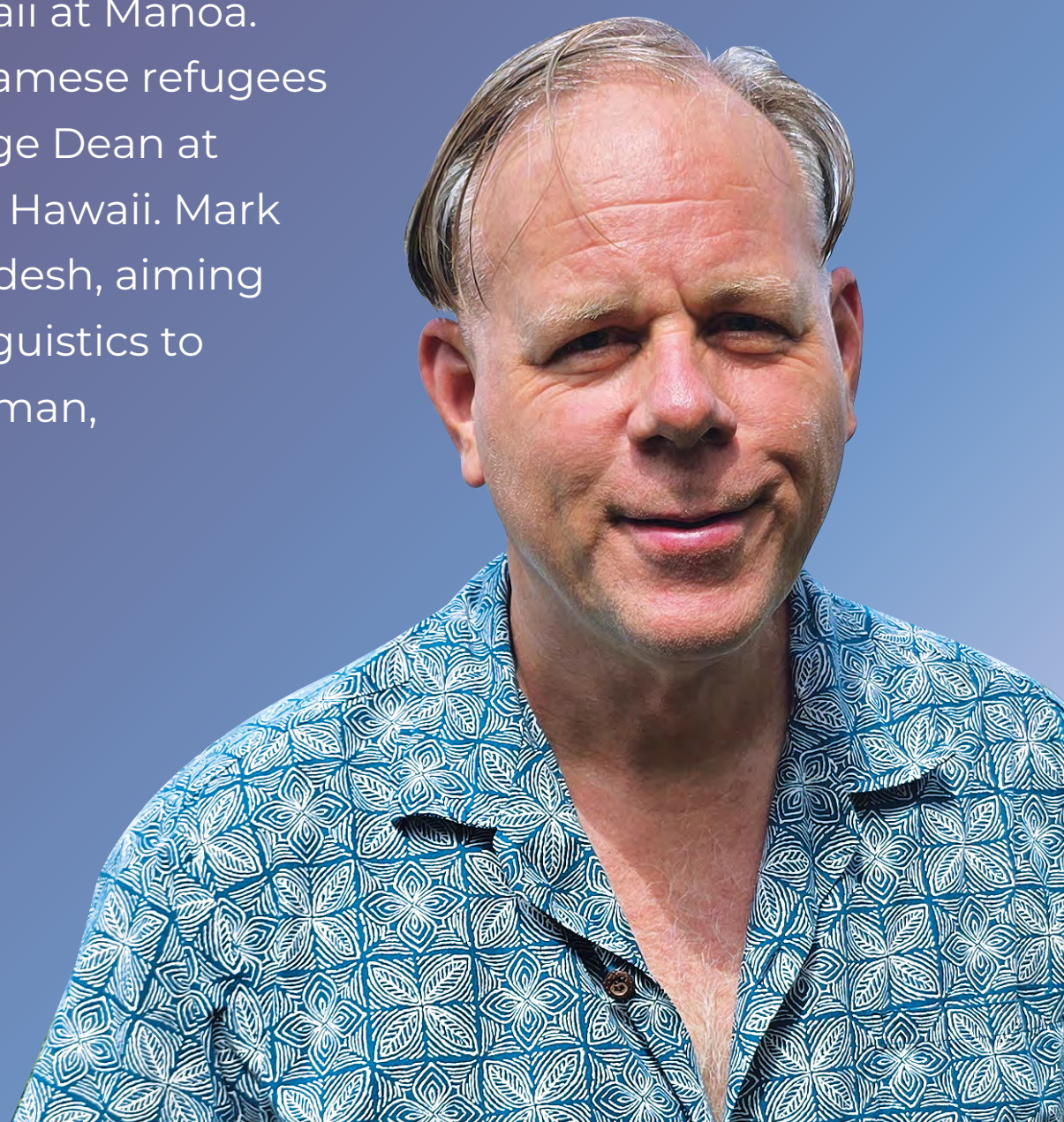

In terms of knowledge, participants will understand the capabilities and limitations of GenAI, as well as its intersections with Christian faith and theology. In terms of attitudes, participants will develop appropriate responses and the confidence to use GenAI for God's purposes and the common good. In terms of skills, participants will practise prompt engineering to optimise the quality and relevance of GenAI outputs.

Prerequisites: (a) basic knowledge of AI and its applications, (b) general digital literacy, including internet use, and (c) an openness to exploring how AI intersects with Christian faith and practice.

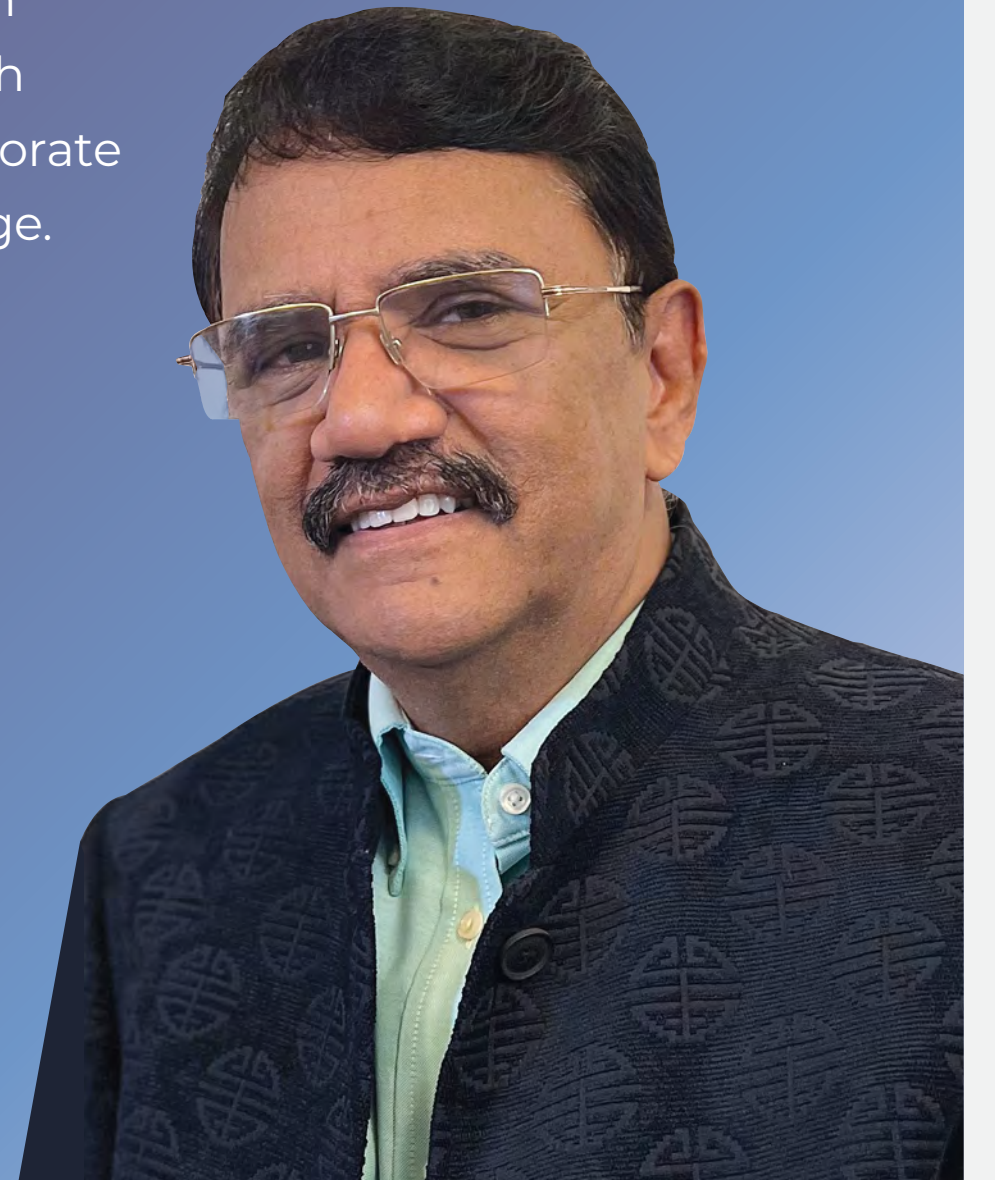
